**A. 3 (Breed Specialists)**

- 1) Minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and to have the support of The Greenland Dog Club of Great Britain (Kennel Club policy)
- 2) To have judged the breed at 3 championship or open shows
- 3) To have judged a minimum of 20 dogs (hands on)
- 4) To have stewarded at 12 shows
- 5) To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club accredited trainer on conformation and movement (Kennel Club policy as of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2001)
- 6) To have attended a Conformation and Movement "Hands-on Assessment" conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. (Kennel Club Policy as of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2005)
- 7) To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club accredited trainer and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club regulations and judging procedures (Kennel Club policy as of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2001)
- 8) To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club code of best practise and passed an examination and / or assessment where applicable (Kennel Club policy as of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2001)

**A. 3 (Non – Breed Specialists)**

- 1) Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in Greenland Dogs) and to have the support of the Greenland Dog Club of Great Britain (Kennel Club policy)
- 2) To have awarded C.C.s in at least one other breed. (Kennel Club policy)
- 3) To have judged the breed at Championship or Open shows in U.K.
- 4) To have judged a minimum of 20 dogs (hands on)

**B (Breed Specialists)**

- 1) To have had a minimum of 5 years owning and / or exhibiting this breed and to have the support of the Greenland Dog club of Great Britain.
- 2) To have attended a Greenland Dog breed specific judges seminar as approved by the Greenland Dog Club of Great Britain.

**B (Non - Breed Specialists)**

- 1) To have had a minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed and to have the support of the Greenland Dog club of Great Britain.
- 2) To have judged the breed at least once at Championship or Open show level
- 3) To have attended a Greenland Dog breed specific judges seminar as approved by the Greenland Dog Club of Great Britain.

**C** For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the Greenland Dog Club of Great Britain
